The Parish borders on Mounts Bay and sits in the Cornwall Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) to the south of the A394 (Penzance to Helston road) and the Cornwall and West Devon Mining World Heritage Site (WHS) to the north of the A394.

The Parish Council Neighbourhood Development Plan is out for Reg 14 consultation at present and we have a number of exciting projects in their development stages. We are also active members of the West Penwith Community Network Forum.

There is a small office within St Piran's Hall in Goldsithney where as the clerk you will be based for the majority of your working hours, though some working from home can be negotiated.
